## OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERS – 2016-2017 SEASON

### DUES

- (a) Dues for the 2016-17 are \$50 for members with electronic access and \$65 for members without.
- (b) The respective dues shall be decreased by \$15 if paid by the Christmas Meeting (December 18, 2016).
- (c) The respective dues shall be increased by \$30 if not paid by the last chapter meeting (Feb 26, 2017).

### ATTENDANCE

1. Eligibility for maintaining membership in the BCBOA shall depend upon actual attendance at Chapter meetings. Attendance at a minimum of six (6) meetings, **not** including the annual interpretation meeting, is required of all members. A maximum of three (3) meeting credits may be received before the first play date of the season.
2. Any official without the required six (6) meetings must submit his reason for absence, in writing, to the Secretary. One excuse must be submitted for **each** meeting the member did not attend; i.e., a member who has attended only five meetings must submit an excuse for **each** meeting date other than the five which were attended or credited. No excuse or appeal will be accepted seventy-two (72) hours after the last chapter meeting; i.e., the election meeting for the year. The Fact Finding Committee will rule on the validity of all excuses. The Secretary will then communicate, in writing, to the P.I.A.A. Executive Director, the names of the officials who have not attended six chapter meetings or have not submitted accepted excuses for absences.
3. Officiating P.I.A.A. contests WILL NOT be considered as a valid excuse, providing the official submits to the Chapter Secretary his working assignment.

## REMINDER FOR THE 2016-2017 SEASON

An Unsportsmanlike Disqualification (UD) results when a single flagrant personal or technical foul or the second technical foul is charged to a player. The head coach or bench personnel are UD for a single flagrant technical or two direct technical fouls.

OFFICIALS ARE TO FILE A REPORT WITH THE PIAA OFFICE ON-LINE WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE EJECTION OR THEY MAY BE PLACED ON PROBATION. OFFICIALS SHOULD GO TO THE "FORMS SECTION" UNDER THE OFFICIALS TAB AT [www.piaa.org](http://www.piaa.org). Additionally, in a BCIAA game, the BCIAA Executive Director, the BCIAA Assignor and the schools' Athletic Directors must be notified by telephone, usually by the morning after the contest and mailed or faxed a copy of the PIAA report. Disqualified basketball player, coach, and/or Team personnel shall not be permitted to participate for the remainder of the day and in all contests on the next contest day of the same level (varsity, junior varsity, or otherwise) of competition from which the player, coach, and/or team personnel was previously disqualified. The enforcement of all suspensions will be the responsibility of each school's athletic administration. Officials have **NO** responsibility in enforcement of game suspensions.

If UD would occur, the procedure would be for the official to notify the scorer and have the scorer record the UD in the scorebook. In the event of UD, players are to remain at their benches. Coaches or bench personnel are ejected to the team's locker room or outside the building or gym.

The second technical foul is always considered unsportsmanlike and he/she must sit out the next game at the same level and the balance of that day. If a player has four personal fouls and commits an act that is not sportsmanlike but is a technical foul, that player is disqualified from the game but not suspended for the next game. If, however, the player with four personal fouls commits a flagrant fifth foul, he/she must sit out the next game. The disqualification rule is for those acts that are unsportsmanlike or flagrant in nature and cause ejection from the game.

**BCIAA JUNIOR HIGH BASKETBALL RULES:**

- JH varsity and JV (pony) games will consist of four (4) 6 minute quarters.
- The time between the varsity and JV game should not exceed five (5) minutes.
- No overtime is played in either game.

**Pony Games:**

- During the JV (pony) games, teams may utilize a full – court, man-to-man press until one team has a 15 – point lead. The team that is losing may still press once the 15-point differential is reached. If the score differential drops below 15 points, both teams may utilize a full court, man –to –man press.
- There are no zone presses or zone defenses of any kind permitted during the JH JV (pony) game.

**2016-17 PIAA Adoptions and Modifications**

- Adopt the 2016-2017 NFHS Basketball Rules Book.
- Adopt Rules 1-13-2 and 1-13-2 NOTE, Coaching box and alternate placement of same, at all levels (varsity, junior varsity, or otherwise) of competition;
- Modify Rule 3-3-8 (Concussion Rule), to clarify that “an appropriate health-care professional” is a licensed physician of medicine or osteopathic medicine (MD or DO);
- Adopt Rule 5-5 NOTE, running clock, at all levels (varsity, junior varsity, or otherwise) of competition, upon completion of the first half, if one Team gains a 40-point differential over its opponent, the clock shall be stopped only when an official's time-out is taken, a charged timeout is granted, a period ends, or during administering of free throws;
- Adopt Rule 10-5-1, the Head Coach, at all levels (varsity, junior varsity, or otherwise) of competition, may be off the bench in front of his/her seat within the confines of the designated 14-foot coaching box to give instructions to his/her players and/or substitutes.

### **Reminders Regarding 2016-2017 Ratings:**

Since the 2014-2015 season and thereafter, BCBOA officials otherwise eligible to receive initial game assignments (IGA) from the BCBOA Assignor must have submitted at least 60% of their previous season ratings for each gender of games (boys or girls) and level of games (Varsity or Junior Varsity) to receive an IGA at that level and for that gender.

Ratings shall be submitted on the [Arbiter Sports](#) website.

### **Reminders Regarding On-Court Sessions:**

BCBOA officials during their first three (3) years with the chapter should attend at least one of the on-court sessions each year sponsored by the chapter to receive initial game assignments.

### **Contacting your partners before games:**

You should be contacting your partners by email or telephone before your scheduled game assignments including scrimmages. The list of officials is constantly being updated you will no longer be provided this list on "paper." The most current list will be on the BCBOA web site for your downloading and printing under the "Staff & Roster Book" button. Check periodically for the most updated list since the roster and phone numbers of officials are constantly changing. You may also go to the Arbiter button on the BerksBOA web page to secure contact information regarding your partners.

### **PIAA Mercy Rule:**

Adopt Rule 5-5 Note, running clock, at all levels (varsity, junior varsity, or otherwise) of competition, upon completion of the first half and one team gains a 40-point differential over its opponent, the clock shall be stopped only when an official's time-out is taken, a charged time-out is granted, a period ends, or administering free throws.

### **PIAA Sportsmanship Message:**

**All officials MUST read this message to captains and head coaches prior to games at all levels.** "PIAA requires all registered sports' officials to enforce the sportsmanship rules for coaches and contestants. Actions meant to demean opposing contestants, team, spectators, and officials are not in the highest ideals of interscholastic education and will not be tolerated. Let today's contest reflect mutual respect. Coaches please certify to the officials that your players are legally equipped and uniformed according to NFHS rules and PIAA adoptions. Good luck in today's contest."



## **Cancellation of Meetings due to Inclement Weather**

Due to the possibility of inclement weather on the day of a meeting, your Executive Committee will employ the following notification process for the current season.

It shall be the responsibility of the BCBOA President to determine approximately two hours or as soon as practicable before the scheduled meeting time to cancel the meeting or not. If the President is not available or will not be attending the meeting, the Vice President will be responsible to carry out the procedure. The President (or Vice President) will have the Secretary email the chapter members and contact radio stations to post the cancellation.
